## MASSTIME CHANGES FROM THE BEGINNING OF NOVEMBER

In July, when the Churches opened again with restrictions on numbers, we moved Mass times and places so that people could get to Mass, but not necessarily at the time or place that they were used to. Most of you have done this, and I am very grateful for your understanding. We are trying to do our best in a difficult situation, and trying to do our best for you.

After four months, we know more about what is going on on the ground, where people are going to Mass and when, and where they are coming from. We also know our limitations. Currently there are nine Masses over the four parishes. Some are almost full, others almost empty. So we are cutting one Mass and moving one other. There will be still one more Mass being said over the weekend than before the Lockdown.

We will continue to monitor the situation, and I am sure that the Mass times will change again in the coming year. But we do not know when or where. We have to be flexible.

Again, we would both like to thank you for your support to us as we have tried to do the best for the parishes in our care.

We need to come back to Holy Mass and worship the living God, together, as the people He has called

## Current Standing Order Donations

The way in which Standing Order donations are made to the parish needs to change because of the introduction of a new computer system being used by the Diocese to make Gift Aid claims.

The new system requires that donations are paid directly into the Parish bank account rather than via a diocesan bank account.

The Diocese will shortly be writing to all current Standing Order Donors asking them to complete a new Standing Order (or, if preferred, a Direct Debit) made payable directly to the parish and to cancel their existing Standing Orders paid to the Diocese. This change will benefit the parish as they will receive your donation directly each month without this processing delay.

Your donation is extremely valuable to your parish and the Diocese, and we would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your ongoing generosity and support.
